Selected as 1 of 5 overall winners in North America, this crew of 8 headed to Tortuga, BVI, to race some of the best in the world.

A collective group of the current who's-who in sailing greeted them—international sailing hero's, Volvo Ocean Racers, TV/Movie stars, Sailing World Magazine, former America's Cup crew and even the Disney Films star from the sailboat racing movie *Morning Light*.

A series of six races made up the week-long regatta on One Design 41-foot boats:

- Leg O Cruise to Cooper Island
- Leg 1 The Channel Islands Race
- Leg 2 Spring Bay to Leverick Bay, Virgin
- Leg 3 Leverick Bay, Virgin Gorda to Anagada
- Leg 4 Anegada to Sandy Cay
- Leg 5 Sandy Cay to Norman Island
- Leg 6 Windward/Leeward Racing in The Bight Bay



This series of races led them to regatta stops that offered geological formations millions of years old in The Baths, guided them to the bar at the end of world, and even jumping off the transom to snorkel with a school of tarpon. Did they win? No. Did they care? No. Their finish kept them in the mix with some extremely talented pros and amateurs, but, honestly, their biggest concern was keeping the drinks cold for each race.




